I - 502 PRESENTATION

Director Rick Garza provided an overview of the proposed rules, agency objectives for implementing I-502, timelines and proposed rule additions and changes.

LCB Agency Objectives:

- Creating a tightly controlled and regulated marijuana market
- Including strict controls to present diversion, illegal sales and sale to minors
- Providing reasonable access to products to mitigate the illicit market

LCB Role & Responsibilities:

- Ensuring public safety it the top priority
- Creating an three-tier regulatory system for marijuana
- Crating licenses for producers, processors and retailers
- Enforcing laws and rules pertaining to licensees
- Collecting and distributing taxes

Timeline:

December 6, 2012 Effective date of new law May 16, 2013 Draft rules sent to stakeholders for input and vetting July 3, 2013 Proposed rules filed with Code Reviser (CR 102) August 6-8, 2013 Public hearings on proposed rules September 4, 2013 Supplemental CR102 filed with Code Reviser October 9, 2013 **Public Hearing** October 16, 2013 Rules Adopted November 16, 2013 Rules become effective November 18, 2013 Begin accepting applications for all three licenses (30-day window) Mandate by law to adopt final rules December 1, 2013 March-April 2014 Begin issuing producer, processor and retailer licenses
